

NSW LABOR'S PLAN FOR THE HOUSING CRISIS

- Protecting tenants from unfair evictions by requiring them to be given a lawful reason for terminating a lease
- Banning the practice of secret rent-bidding, which pits tenants against each other in a bidding war
- Creating a Rental Commissioner and implementing a Portable Bond Scheme to allow tenants to apply their current bond to their next lease
- Introducing a mandatory requirement for 30% of all homes built on surplus government land to be set aside for social, affordable and diverse housing
- Longer term funding certainty for homelessness support organisations dealing with the fall-out from the housing crisis
